Regular Meeting of August 17, 2016.

Monique began the meeting by reading the biography of George G. Morgan who lives near Tampa, Florida.

His live one-hour webinar this evening was entitled, "Genealogy Orienteering" after which there was a Question and Answer period.

Mr. Morgan's interesting webinar included tips on using the correct books and censuses for research. His 4-page handout was available at our meeting and will be a very helpful document for those who need to use maps in their family tree studies.

The Book Bucket was explained for the benefit of the visitors and passed around to those present.

Then they said they couldn't find anything!

Ruth Self mentioned that in her research, her family was living right on a county line and very difficult to find.

Monique reminded everyone to be sure and come to our next meeting on September 21, 2016 when our former speaker, Janice Sellers will speak on "Grandma, Who Are You?"

The Book Bucket winner was Catherine Graham.

Karen Rain asked if there would be a webinar at the next workshop on September 7, 2016. Colleen Allen responded by saying she wasn't certain yet. We'll have to wait and see.

Ruth noted that as of September 1, 2016 we will have a new librarian, Jan Robbins.
